

# Know your Stone Age Tools

Crafted and used during the Paleolithic era

Round with sharp edges and flat surfaces

Usually made from stone/flint

Used to cut, dig, and crush



Crafted and used during the Neolithic era

One end sharp, the other round and curved

Usually very small

Often used in combat against other humans

Made from flint

Crafted and used during the Neolithic era through to the Bronze Age

Shaped like a triangle

Consists of three points at the bottom which helped in hunting

Made from metals or flint

Crafted and used during the Neolithic era

Long and curved with sharp edges

Made from flint and usually had a wooden handle

Used to cut and harvest

Crafted and used during the Mesolithic era

Shaped like a knife blade

Very small

Usually made from stone/flint

Can cut and drill. Also used as arrowheads
